Campus Ministry

Each year over 50,000 students and visiting scholars come to NYC to study. Each semester we host English conversation groups and outreach events that draw hundreds of students on several major university campuses.

Those who express interest in spiritual things are invited to discovery Bible studies where they'll learn key Bible stories from Creation to Christ. Many of our students have come to faith and returned home with a desire to reach their family and friends and start churches.

During the 2016 Fall Semester more than 300 students participated in English conversation groups. Our team led 30 discovery Bible studies with 100+ participants, many of whom were reading the Bible for the first time.

EQUIP: 12 Month Training

EQUIP is an intensive, year-long training program designed to develop church planters in the context of practical ministry experience. The focus of Equip training is organic, reproducible church planting among unreached peoples.

Each trainee is mentored by an experienced church planter. Through study and application, you'll grow in your understanding of the gospel and develop a philosophy of evangelism, discipleship and church planting that is highly reproducible.

What you learn through Equip you can apply to your own neighborhood or wherever else God may lead you in the world.

There are 25,000 workers in the United Nations, some from least-evangelized countries. Our team has a history of working with diplomats and bringing the gospel to them, their colleagues and their families.

Jisru

Jisru is the Arabic word for "bridge". The Jisru ministry is specifically focused on building bridges for sharing the gospel with Muslim communities in New York City. This team's focus is on abundant gospel sowing, incarnational evangelism, and starting discovery Bible studies in Muslims homes.

LuShin returned home to baptize the new believers, and they are meeting together as a community of believers in a city with no other churches!
